We seek to help groups of believers attain their greatest potential, whether that takes the form of a Bible study group, Sunday school, church or a Christian camp.

### *Vision, Goals and Objectives*

Our desire is to minister to families and churches in Western Colorado through Mountaintop Retreat, a Christian camping ministry, Bible studies and other types of Christian ministries. The biggest mission field in America is our youth. The need to present the gospel of Jesus Christ to young people has never been at a more critical juncture in American history. The Christian camping experience is a beacon in the dark for hundreds of young people each year. As Director of Mountaintop Retreat, I have seen the dramatic change in the lives of young people that have accepted Christ as Savior at camp. Our ministry includes disciplining these young people. It is also our desire to expand the camping programs at the camp to reach and minister to not only youth but the entire family. We accomplish this by making our facilities available to the local churches and other ministries throughout the year. We also desire to see new ministries started that will help build the local churches through new converts. Our ministry is one of helping churches through our camping ministry.

## Personal History

I was born in Nebraska and raised on my parents' ranches both in Nebraska and South Dakota. I received Jesus Christ as my personal savior at age 13 during a Vacation Bible School, held in a rural country school, directed by an American Sunday School Union Missionary. I served in the U.S. Navy from 1968 to 1972 and received an honorable discharge. I met and married Vicky in the spring of 1972. Vicky was born in Washington State and raised in Southern California where she accepted the Lord as her savior at the age of 15. From 1972 to 1980, I worked as a rancher, welder in a shipyard and as a building contractor. Vicky and I have two boys, Jason and Ryan, who are grown. Vicky and I are now raising our grandson Cash whom we have adopted. He was placed in our home on January 4th 2011 when he was two months old. We surrendered for full time ministry at a mission's conference in 1978. In January of 1980, we enrolled in Prairie Bible College in Canada. I graduated in the spring of 1984 and spent the next year as a Bible teacher and Dean of Students at Sunshine Bible Academy, a Christian High School in Miller, SD,

Upon becoming American Missionary Fellowship Missionaries (now called Infaith), we spent 10 years in Montana where we helped plant and administer a church, conducted numerous Vacation Bible Schools and home Bible studies in the surrounding rural areas. In October 1994, Vicky and I moved to Colorado where I now serve as Director of Mountaintop Retreat.
